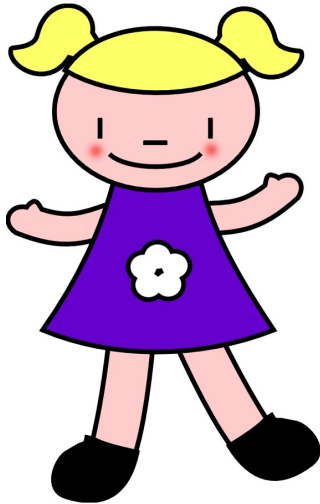

## Doll Mascot

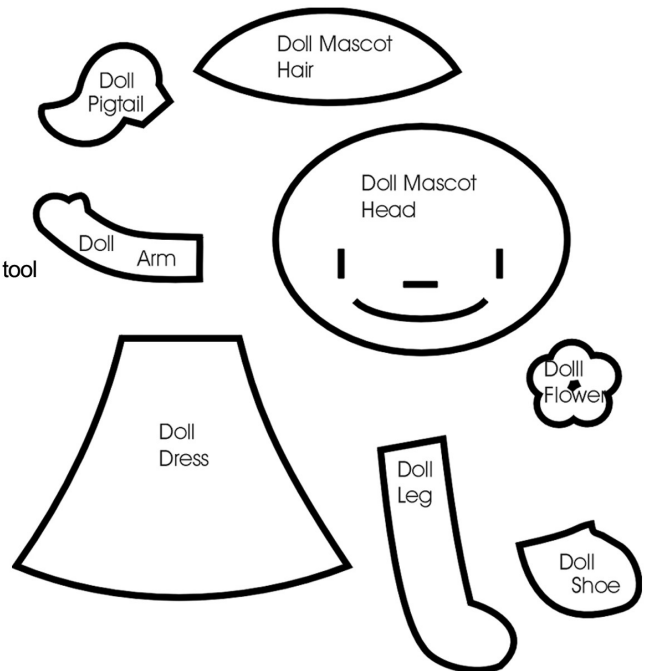


### Supplies

Felt in tan, yellow, purple, black and white  
Embroidery floss in black, tan, yellow, purple, white  
Seed bead for center of flower  
Needle  
Stuffing  
Bamboo skewer or other stuffing tool  
Red pastel pencil

### Cutting (felt)

Dress x 2 (purple)  
Arm x 4 (tan)  
Leg x 4 (tan)  
Pigtail x 4 (yellow)  
Hair x 1 (yellow)  
Head x 1 (tan)  
Head x 1 (yellow)  
Shoe x 4 (black)  
Flower X 1 (white)

All pieces sewn with hand overcast stitch unless otherwise specified. Six-strand embroidery floss recommended.

1. Stitch hair to doll face, along edge of bangs/fringe using 1 strand of yellow thread.
2. Stitch line for eyes, nose, stem stitch for mouth, using three strands of black.
3. Use red pastel pencil to make rosy cheeks
4. Sew two pigtail pieces together using single strand of yellow thread, leaving small edge open. Stuff. Repeat for second pigtail.
5. Overcast face and back of head together, catching small edge of pigtails between layers. Use single strand of yellow in hair area and tan in face area. Leave chin open, slightly wider than top of dress. Stuff head.
6. Sew two arm pieces together, with single strand of tan, leaving opening on small edge. Stuff. Repeat for second arm.
7. Sew two leg pieces together, using single strand of tan, leaving small edge open. Put shoe piece on top and underneath, sandwiching foot inside. Sew around edge using single strand of black. Stuff leg. Repeat for other leg.
8. Sew flower on front of dress, with one strand of white thread, using bead as center.
9. Sew around edge of dress with single purple thread, catching arms and legs. Leave neck open.
10. Stuff dress.
11. Insert top of dress into head piece.
12. Sew chin area closed, catching dress, using single strand of tan.
